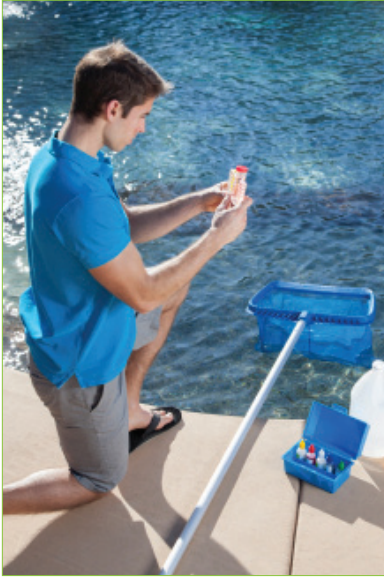


BE A RESPONSIBLE POOL OWNER



Mosquitoes need water to breed and will gladly use your swimming pool as a breeding site unless you take the necessary steps to remove standing water from your backyard.

WHAT POOL OWNERS CAN DO:

Properly disinfect and filter the water in your pool to prevent mosquitoes from breeding. Mosquitoes will not breed in water that is suitable for active swimming.

Apply insecticide products that are meant for use in pools and follow the label instructions.

When not in use, make sure your pool cover is secured so mosquitoes cannot access the water under the cover.

Make sure any water that accumulates on top of the cover is completely drained on a regular basis.

Drain and cover any unused pools.

OTHER WATER SOURCES CAN BE BREEDING GROUNDS:

Wading pools should be emptied and turned over when not in use.

Water in birdbaths should be refreshed every other day.

Pet dishes should have fresh water every other day.

Flower pots that are collecting water should be drained.

Leaky faucets that may be creating puddles should be fixed.
