



This program provides educational and prenatal case care coordination services to pregnant women.

The goal is to have a healthy pregnancy and a healthy baby.

Services provided include:

- Access to a health care provider and care coordination.
- Providing community referrals.
- Educating clients on prenatal nutrition and WIC services.
- Providing education on pregnancy and childbirth.
- Home visits will begin during pregnancy and continue through six weeks after the baby is born.
- A nurse will visit you in your home each trimester.
- In addition to home visits, a nurse will see you monthly. These visits may be held at the WIC Clinic, your doctor's office, or your home.
