**Please check any two (2) risks for the pregnant client:** Eligibility is < 25 weeks gestation. If you check HIV or repeated STD infections (excluding bacterial vaginosis) or current pregnancy is multi-fetus, then you only need 1 risk to be eligible for the program.

✓ Risk Factors for the Pregnant Client	
	Previous Preterm Birth(History of pre-term births, stillbirths, 2 or more miscarriages)
	Alcohol or other substance abuse
	Tobacco use continued during pregnancy
	Chronic diseases that affect pregnancy (diabetes, hypertension, obesity)
	Pre-pregnancy weight less than 100 pounds or during pregnancy
	Pre-pregnancy BMI equal to or greater than 30
	More than fourth pregnancy or third child within 40 months
	HIV or repeated STD infections (excluding bacterial vaginosis)
	Under age 15
	Current pregnancy is multi-fetus
	Victim of domestic violence
	DSM V Classification Diagnosis (Mental Health)
	Low educational attainment (over 18 with less than 10 <sup>th</sup> grade education)
	Homeless or in temporary housing
	Previously incarcerated or under house arrest
	Previously had/currently has a child in DCFS custody or self is currently in DCFS custody
