Media Alert: Daily COVID-19 Case Counts* for DuPage County

Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Case Counts* in DuPage County, 2020	
Total cases in DuPage County residents	Total Willowbrook long-term care facility outbreak-associated cases
1,057 (158 outbreak-associated** and 899 non-outbreak-associated cases), including 46 deaths	53 (34 residents and 19 staff), including 9 deaths

*Data are provisional as of 11:00am 4/11/2020 and subject to change.

**Outbreak-associated cases are linked to a congregate setting (e.g., long-term care facilities, workplaces, schools) or large gathering (e.g., convention, concert).

Since yesterday, there are 48 new cases of COVID-19 in DuPage County including seven deaths reported.

Regarding the 158 outbreak-associated cases (including 24 deaths) among DuPage County residents:

- 42 cases (including 9 deaths) are attributed to the Willowbrook long-term care facility (LTCF),
- 87 cases (including 15 deaths) are attributed to 18 additional LTCFs, and
- 29 cases are attributed to 11 outbreaks in other congregate settings and large gatherings.

DuPage County Health Department (DCHD) announces seven additional deaths of persons with COVID-19 infection reported since yesterday:

- Male resident of a Carol Stream long-term care facility in his 80s with underlying conditions,
- Female resident of a Lisle long-term care facility in her 90s with underlying conditions,
- Female resident of a Burr Ridge long-term care facility in her 80s with underlying conditions,
- Female resident of a Burr Ridge long-term care facility in her 90s with underlying conditions,
- Female resident of a Willowbrook long-term care facility in her 80s with underlying conditions,
- Male resident of DuPage County in his 60s with underlying conditions who had been living in the community, and
- Male resident of DuPage County in his 80s with underlying conditions who had been living in the community.

DCHD offers our condolences to the families and caregivers of these individuals. We remain committed to address the unfortunate loss of life related to COVID-19. Our efforts continue with healthcare and community partners to reduce COVID-19 transmission in DuPage County.
