COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER

Trained Community Health Workers from the DuPage County Health Department will provide information and enrollment assistance.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

If you are uninsured or underinsured and live in DuPage County, you may be eligible for assistance.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

A Community Health Worker will schedule an appointment for you at the DuPage County Health Department or you can call: (630) 682-7400 and ask for a benefitting appointment.

At your appointment, the Community Health Worker will work with you to enroll in benefits.

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION.

SERVICES INCLUDE

- ◆ Assistance with health insurance enrollment
- ◆ Linkage to primary care doctors
- ◆ Access to behavioral health services
- ◆ Access to dental health services
- ◆ Assistance with food benefits
- ◆ Referrals to transportation assistance
- ◆ Referrals to additional community based resources

Client Documentation Needed for Application Assistance

Any client seeking benefit application assistance will need to bring personal documents and information in order to successfully file an application.

Below you will see the types of documents needed depending on which benefit program you may be interested in applying for.

Proof of Income

- Examples include statements of wages, Social Security card, pensions, unemployment, child support, etc.
- If no income: Proof of income (90 days) for the person(s) helping you financially and a letter of support written by them.
- If self-employed: Recent Federal Tax Returns and 3 months recent bank statements showing deposits of income.
- If paid in cash: 3 months bank statements showing the deposits of income. If you file taxes you may also use them with the employer letter.

Proof of Address – Please provide ONE of the following:

- Utility bill (must be issued within the last 30 days).
Driver's license or state identification (ID) (only if issued within the last 30 days).
- Current lease or proof of mortgage.
- If you live with someone else and have none of the documents listed above to prove your address, please take the following actions:
 - Provide a letter from the person you live with indicating you reside with him or her.
 - Have the person writing the letter provide one of the above proof of address documents in his or her name.

Social Security Card or number(s)

Proof of income (30 days)

Valid photo ID, Birth Certificate, US Passport.

- If not a US citizen please provide lawful permanent resident (LPR) documents
- Proof of Income for 90 days for all types of earned or unearned income (wages, self-employment, Social Security, pensions, unemployment, etc.)
- Proof of Illinois Residency

Social Security card or number(s)

Valid photo ID

LPR Documents, if applicable

Current year's income for all household members including young adults up to age 26
