The DuPage County Health Department provides further information on our data dashboard for COVID-19-related cases by age group, hospitalizations, deaths, lab positivity, outbreak-associated counts by municipality and community transmission level.

Since yesterday, there are 230 new cases of COVID-19 in DuPage County with no deaths of persons with COVID-19 infection reported. Please note, today's death count reflects the reclassification of one death that had previously been counted as a COVID-19-related death.
