Goal 1: Develop understanding of mental health needs that could be served by a potential central receiving center

- Q1 2020 – Add one additional participant PD to mobile crisis pilot (4 total)
- Q4 2020 – Analyze MH coding data at Sheriff's Office and 1 municipal PD
- Q1 2021 – Add one additional participant PD to mobile crisis pilot (5 total)
- Q4 2021 – Hold final EMS Mental Health First Aid trainings (160 total trainees)
- Q4 2021 – Analyze MH coding data from countywide RMS

Goal 2: Improve processes for connecting individuals leaving the DuPage County Correctional Center to mental health treatment

- Q4 2020 – Implement MH and SU screening tools at DCCC
- Q1 2021 – Use screening tool to establish baseline MH needs at DCCC
- Q1 2021 – Initiate Jail Data Link at DCCC
- Q2 2021 – Explore of solution-based housing support
- Q3 2021 – Develop long term plan for DCCC data reporting/sharing

Goal 3: Support continued growth of the Behavioral Health Collaborative's organizational health

- Q4 2020, 2021, 2022 – Evaluate need for change in BHC subcommittees
- Q3 2021 – Review the relevant results from IPLAN assessment reports
- Q2 2022 – Evaluate direction for BHC's focus area (currently mental health & justice)
- Q4 2022 – Approve three-year BHC action plan (2023-25)

Goal 1: Develop understanding of mental health needs that could be served by a potential central receiving center

Objective 1.1: Add additional participant PDs to mobile crisis pilot (5 total)

- Present data from mobile crisis response to Police Chiefs Association
- Work with participating PDs to find ways to make the program more effective

Objective 1.2: Analyze mental health coding data at Sheriff's Office and municipal police departments

- Pilot initial set of mental health indicators to collect from DuPage Sheriff's Office and at least one municipal police department
- Grow to include all DuPage police departments using WebRMS
- Develop standardized list of fields to be collected by all entities for comparison
- Create data sharing agreement to be used between all departments and DuPage County Health Department (the entity performing MH data analysis)
- Create report within WebRMS to pull metrics from PDs passively
- Present countywide aggregate data regularly to BHC and identify next steps for necessary mental health data

Objective 1.3: Train 160 total EMS personnel in specialized EMS Mental Health First Aid

- Train two clinicians in EMS MFHA train-the-trainer course
- Provide summary of benefits of EMS MHFA and available trainings to DuPage Fire Chiefs Association
- Hold quarterly EMS MHFA trainings at DuPage County Health Department
- Conduct onsite EMS MHFA trainings at DuPage fire departments

Goal 2: Improve processes for connecting individuals leaving the DuPage County Correctional Center to mental health treatment

Objective 2.1: Implement mental health and substance use screening tools at DCCC

- Identify which tools are best tailored to screen incoming individuals while not placing undue burden on intake staff
- Create process flow for screening and outcome of positive screen results
- Determine how paper screens are collected, entered electronically, and analyzed
- Create data sharing agreement between DuPage County Sheriff's Office and DuPage County Health Department (the entity performing MH data analysis)

Objective 2.2: Use mental health screening tool to establish baseline mental health needs at DCCC

- Identify which measures will be collected and tracked, frequency of analysis/reporting
- Collect mental health screening results for baseline period of three months
- Meet after baseline period to review results and identify areas of need
- Evaluate after baseline collection if there are new measures that can/should be added

Objective 2.3: Initiate Jail Data Link at DCCC

- Determine staff at DCSO and DCHD that will have access to JDL
- Create legal documents outlining appropriate use and have all entities sign and submit to State of IL
- Receive approval from State of IL and begin use of JDL system

Objective 2.4: Explore solution-based housing support

- Perform literature review of county or municipal justice and mental health housing programs
- Speak with successful existing programs and learn about specific challenges implementing in their communities
- Make detailed recommendations to housing groups in DuPage (Continuum of Care, DuPagePads)

Objective 2.5: Develop long term plan for DCCC data reporting/sharing

- Draft ongoing data sharing agreement between DCSO and DCHD regarding mental health metrics at DCCC
- Identify positions outside of JMHCP grant funding that will perform data entry/analysis
- Meet quarterly to discuss prior months' data and determine if changes need to be made

Goal 3: Support continued growth of the Behavioral Health Collaborative's organizational health

Objective 3.1: Evaluate need for change in BHC subcommittees annually

- Schedule time during Q4 full BHC meetings and Executive Committee meetings to summarize progress to date on subcommittee objectives and work left to be done
- Identify new potential topics for focus that could be served by a dedicated subcommittee

Objective 3.2: Review the relevant results from IPLAN assessment reports

- Participate in Impact DuPage Forces of Change assessment during Q1 2022 BHC meeting
- When published, present mental health data to full BHC
- Meet with Impact DuPage representatives to compare with previous IPLAN results
- Use prioritization results to find ways to align BHC and Impact DuPage objectives

Objective 3.3: Evaluate direction for BHC's focus area

- Review progress to date on existing objectives for the focus area of Justice-Mental Health
- Brainstorm potential new focus areas during full BHC meeting and Executive Committee meeting
- Prioritize potential options and select three-year focus area

Objective 3.4: Approve three-year BHC action plan (2023-25)

- Brainstorm objectives for new focus area during full BHC meeting and Executive Committee meeting
- Organize objectives within different goals to be specifically addressed by new subcommittees
- Draft objectives on three-year timeline and present draft timeline to full BHC and Executive Committee
- Use feedback to alter objectives and present full action plan with associated activities to BHC Executive Committee to vote for approval
