Health Department and COVID-19 Testing Site Closed to Observe Veterans Day

DUPAGE COUNTY— The DuPage County Health Department’s Public Health Centers in Addison, Lombard, West Chicago, Westmont, and Wheaton, as well as the DuPage County COVID-19 Testing Site, will be closed on Wednesday, Nov. 11, 2020, in observance of Veterans Day.

The Health Department’s Crisis Hotline (630) 627-1700 will remain in operation.

All offices will open at their regular times on Thursday, Nov. 12, 2020. The DuPage County COVID-19 Testing Site will open at 7:00 a.m. on Thursday, Nov. 12, 2020.

Additional COVID-19 Mobile Testing sites will be available this week:

- Wednesday, Nov. 11, 2020, at the Bartlett North Metra Lot (corner of Oneida and Eastern Avenues) from 8:00 a.m. to 4 p.m., or until the daily test capacity is met.
- Thursday, Nov. 12, 2020, at the Glendale Heights Aquatics Center from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., or until the test capacity is met.
