- Provides and follows-up on referral and community resource linkage
- Maintains required training, licensure and/or certification
- Consults with staff concerning client and program issues
- Provides related case management services
- Demonstrates independent judgment and discretion in making position related decisions
- Participates in team meetings to assess clients' progress
- Participates in emergency response activities as assigned
