## **DuPage County COVID-19 Community Vaccination Clinic Transitions to Next Vaccine Phase**

**DuPage County**—The DuPage County COVID-19 Community Vaccination Clinic will be decreasing the number of days the clinic is open as vaccination rates rise and more providers are offering COVID-19 vaccines in DuPage County. Last week the DuPage County COVID-19 Community Vaccination Clinic administered its 100,000<sup>th</sup> vaccine dose.

Starting June 18, COVID-19 vaccinations will be available at the DuPage County Community Vaccination Clinic Thursday through Saturday with varying evening and weekend hours to accommodate the public. “With more than 70 percent of our eligible residents having received their first vaccine dose of this life-saving vaccine and over 250 vaccine providers available in DuPage County, we feel confident that there are ample vaccine opportunities for our residents,” said Karen Ayala, Executive Director of DuPage County Health Department. “We now want to further expand our efforts in bringing this safe and highly effective vaccine directly to hard-to-reach populations through our continued partnerships with municipalities, businesses, and local community organizations.”

In addition to the Community Vaccination Clinic, the DuPage County Health Department is encouraging residents to seek vaccination at any of the available 250 sites throughout DuPage County.
